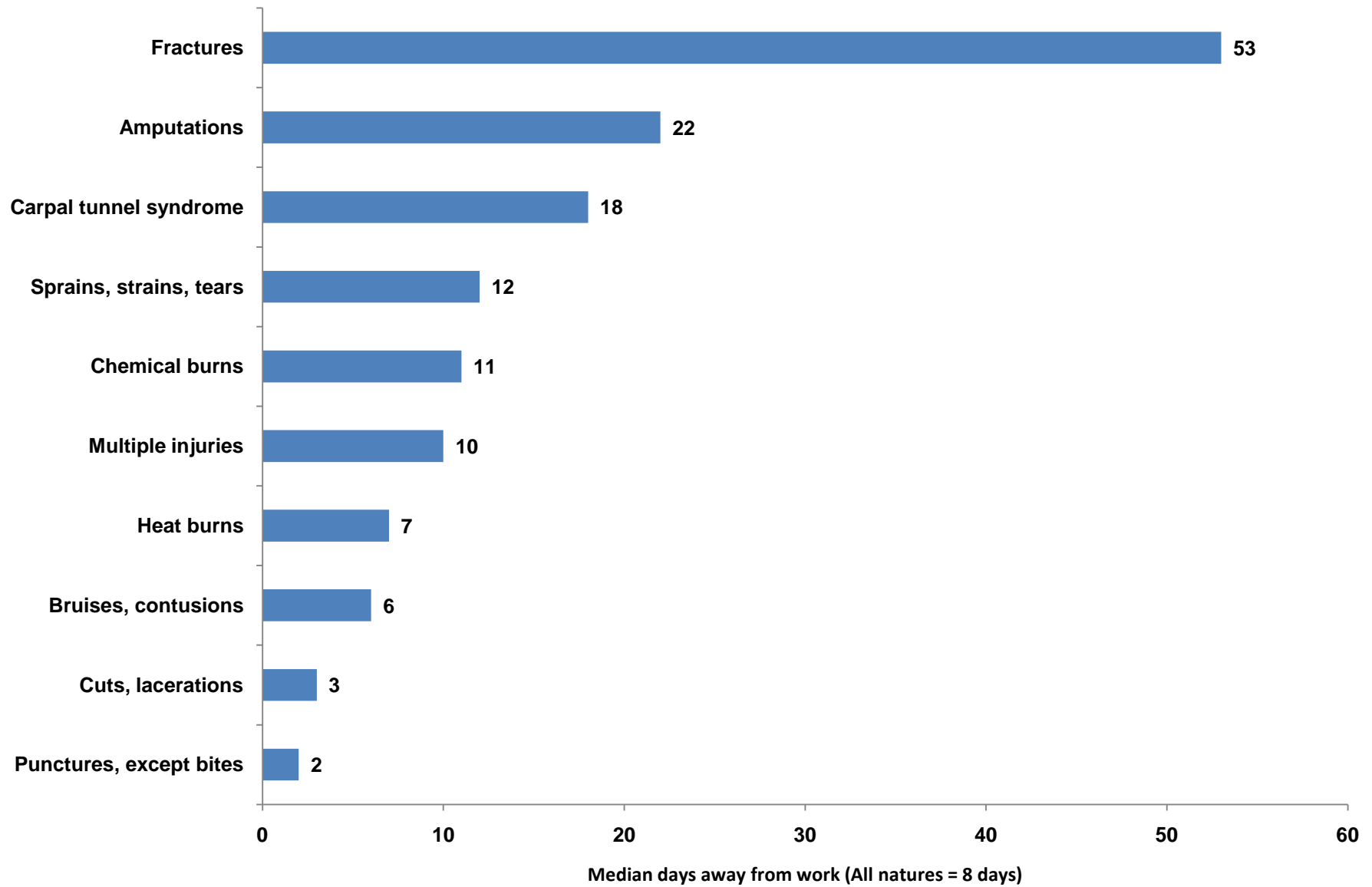
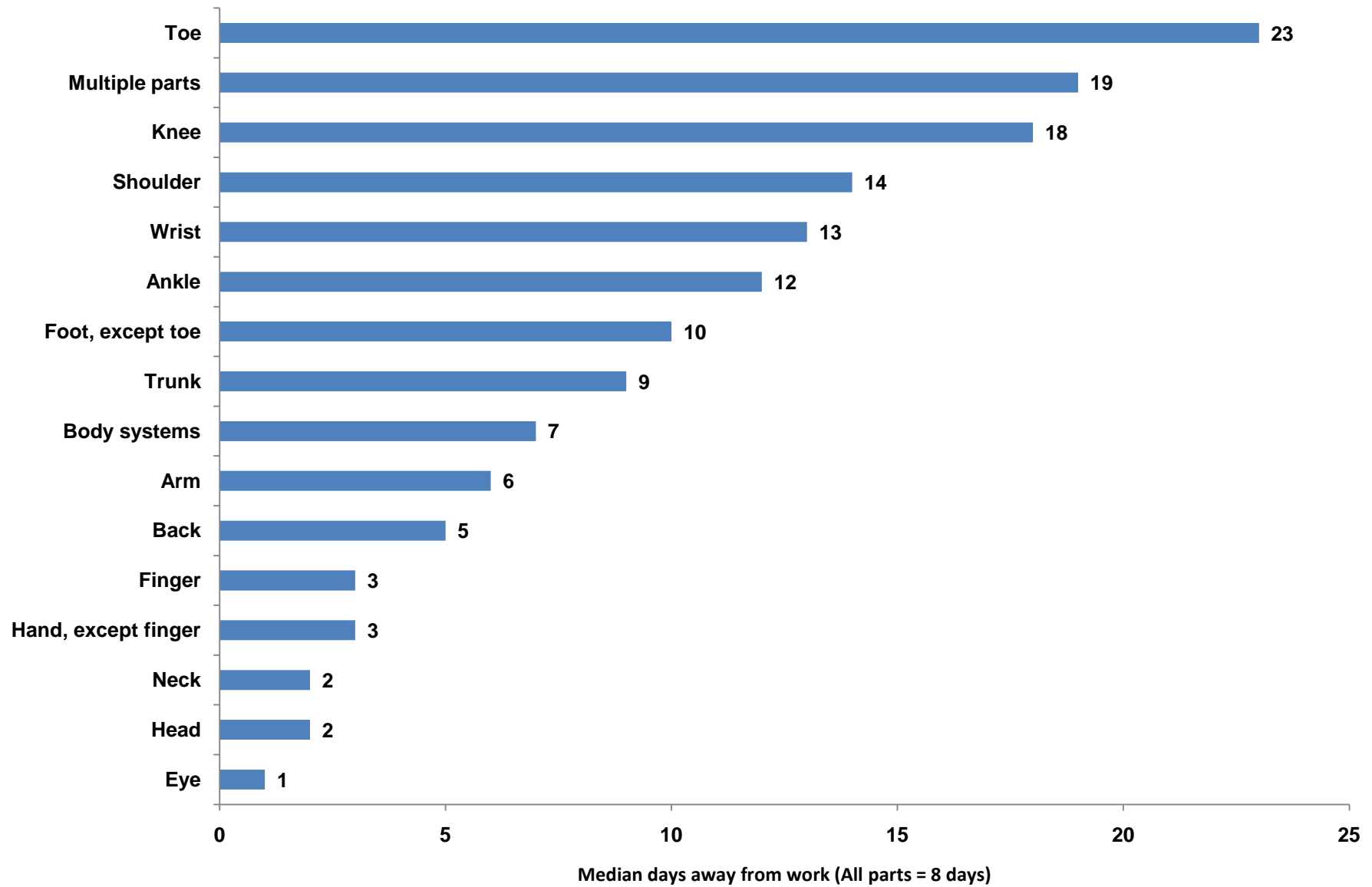


Median days away from work due to injuries or illnesses by nature, South Carolina, private industry, 2009

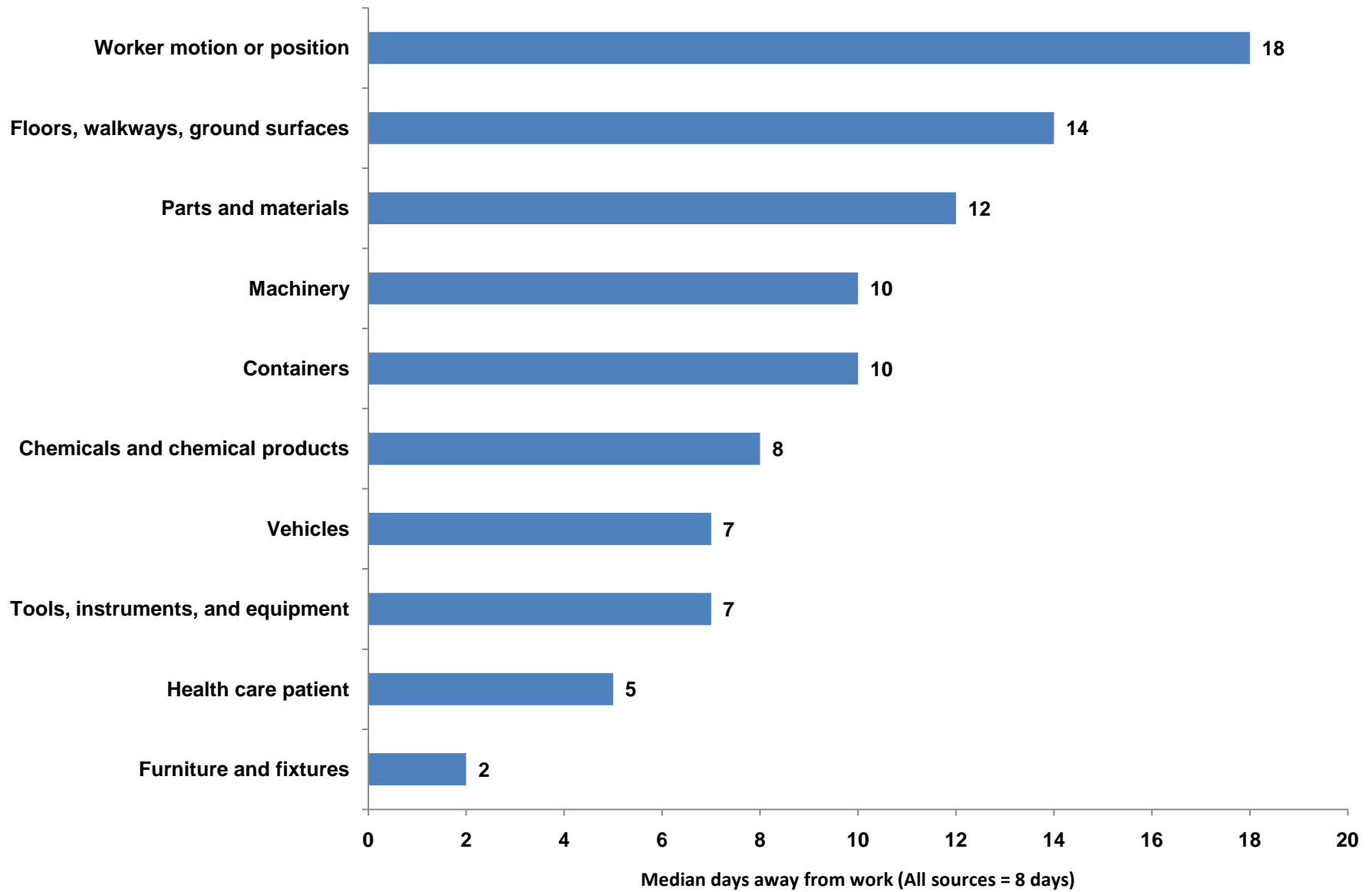

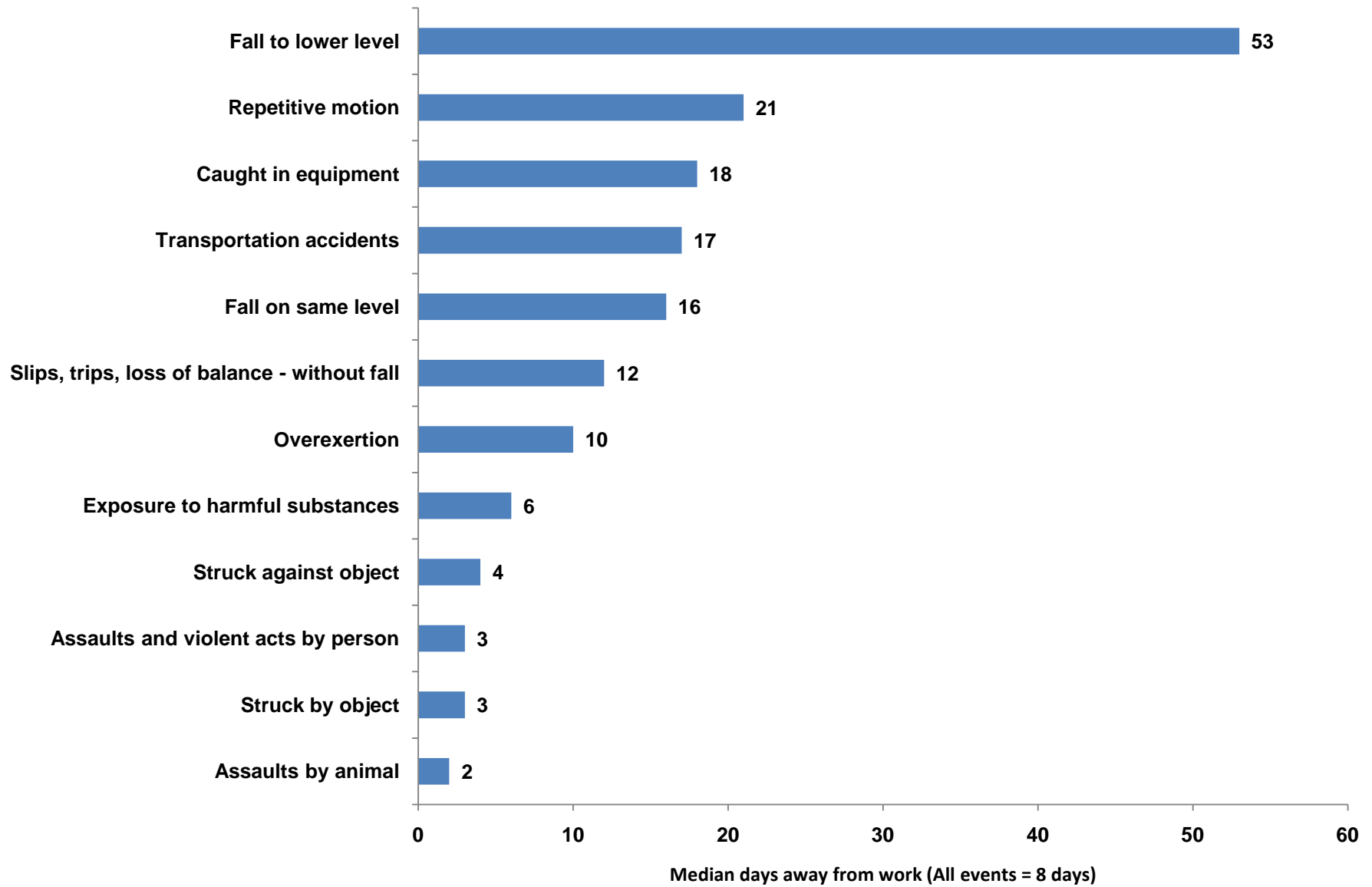
Median days away from work due to injury or illness by part of body affected, South Carolina, private industry, 2009
