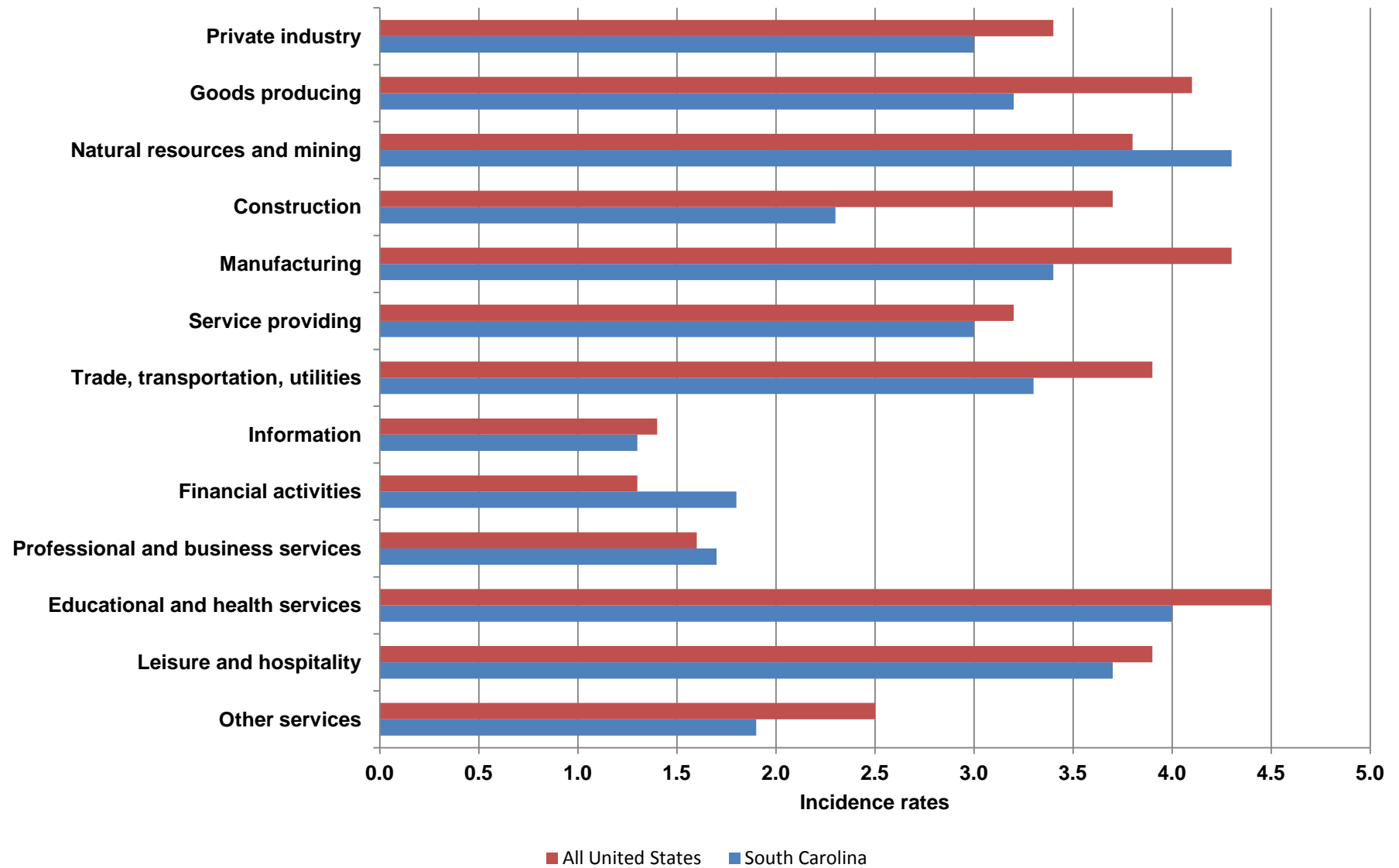


**Incidence rates per 100 full-time workers for
